Educare

Educare supports home-based and center-based licensed and unlicensed, and registered family childcare providers in Pettis County with professional development training, in-home provider visits, extensive resource library of educational toys, educational videos and materials, and also *Kiddie Corner* newsletter for providers.

Retired and Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP)

RSVP helps seniors put their life skills and life experiences to work in our community addressing many critical community needs. Our 248 volunteers provided over 27, 456 hours of service in FY 2006 in areas such as education, transportation, health, social services, conservation and assistance to not-for-profit organizations.

Teen Pregnancy Prevention Coalition

Choosing the Best

Research based prevention program motivates youth to choose abstinence until marriage.

Baby Think it Over

This teen pregnancy prevention program utilizes computerized dolls that simulate what it is like to care for an infant. The program also includes abstinence and infant safety. It is available to schools, youth groups, scouts, and teen organizations.

Unique, That's Me!

A self-esteem program for at 4th and 5th grade girls. Helps develop the skills and tools necessary to face life's challenges. Activities enable the girls to use daily experiences to help build an understanding of what self-esteem is and learn how to recognize and foster it.

Activity Builders for Children – ABC

The ABC group works to raise money so foster children may have the funds for full participation in school and community life. ABC has provided fees for activities such as community sports, extra school events, class rings, senior pictures, and graduation announcements.

MRCC Food Co-op

Partnering with the Missouri Rural Crisis Center, once each month we are able to offer people approximately \$50.00 worth of groceries for \$20.00. Co-op members pay an annual membership fee of \$10.00 and the \$20.00 monthly co-op fee, then each month they receive a supply of food which includes bread, produce, paper products, and canned goods, as well as MRCC's own Patchwork Farms meat products. Additional meat may be ordered at reasonable rates. All participants of the food cooperative must be current MRCC members. Anyone may participate, regardless of income.

PROP – Putting Roofs Over People

PCCP, Sedalia Housing Authority, MO Valley CAA, Open Door, Salvation Army, Habitat for Humanity, DFS, Rural MO, Inc., churches, businesses, and individuals are working together to combat homelessness and provide transitional housing assistance. The program includes case management for families utilizing PROP's assistance. Assistance will be provided to those who qualify as the funds are available.

MO ReEntry Process Steering Group

In an effort to help ex-offenders be successful in returning to the community we are working in concert with the MO Dept. of Corrections and their MO Reentry Process. We have a grant for 20 VISTA members (Volunteers in Service to America) to assist Partnerships in developing resources around housing, education, family support, employment and mental health issues.

REUSABLES

Multicultural Services

Cherishing the diversity of Pettis County residents, PCCP strives to heighten cultural awareness of this rich resource and provide services to assist people as they endeavor to become productive citizens and live in our community.

Services currently available through PCCP include:

West Central Missouri Multicultural Forum

Brings people and regional resources together to proactively (and reactively if necessary) address issues relating to education, health and welfare, business and industry, law enforcement, government, transportation, and community service learning. The Forum meets the first Wednesday of March, June, September, and December.

Literacy Center

Offers adult education, English-as-a-Second Language (ESL), GED preparation, and Citizenship classes.

Sabados Latinos

This 2 hour radio program brings news, school, health, and community information to local residents whose first language is Spanish. The time is donated by KSIS radio (1050 AM) and is staffed by local volunteers. Airs from 9:30-11:30 AM on Saturdays.

Family Nutrition Education (Spanish)

Helps families learn how a well balanced meal promotes child development and adult health.

Pettis County Health Center is a local public health agency that is supported by a special county tax, by reimbursement from federal and state programs and by a sliding fee-for-service scale based on household income. Available services include general health and wellness screens, communicable disease control activities including immunizations, numerous child and adolescent health/safety programs, women's health services, WIC (Women, Infants, and Children) Food Supplement Program, and environmental public health services. Certified Copies of Birth and Death certificates are available in the office for a fee, but only if the birth or death occurred in Missouri.

It is the policy of Pettis County Health Center to provide equal services to all applicants without regard to race, color, religion, gender, age, national origin, political belief, veteran status, and physical or mental disability.
